For over 150 years, Lawrence Hall has been delivering high quality care to at-risk youth and their families throughout the Chicago metropolitan area. Today Lawrence Hall annually serves over 1,000 youth and families, helping to not only transform their lives but also help strengthen the communities where they live.

## Our Programs

### Project Work

Project Work is an integral part of Lawrence Hall's programming and includes: MY TIME, TryMe's, Right Turn, After School Matters, and One Summer Chicago PLUS. Through these programs, Lawrence Hall helps youth develop skills and provide them with the tools needed to obtain and maintain employment.

### Foster Care

Lawrence Hall's Foster Care Program annually provides safe, nurturing homes for over 200 youth (birth through 21 years of age) who have been removed from their birth families due to abuse, neglect, dependency, or abandonment. We take great care in selecting and training foster parents who are able to provide the special care and sense of permanency our traumatized youth need.

### Therapeutic Day School

Lawrence Hall's fully-accredited Therapeutic Day School provides specialized education to meet the needs of students who face extreme difficulty learning in a traditional classroom setting; many are faced with emotional and behavioral disorders as well as learning disabilities that make conventional learning methods unviable.

### Residential Treatment Program

The Child and Family Treatment Center is Lawrence Hall's most acute level of care and a valued placement option when at-risk youth with complex trauma need residential treatment to help them stabilize. Youth at the Center learn how to improve social skills, develop coping mechanisms, form healthy relationships, and maintain a healthy lifestyle.

### Older Adolescent Program

Lawrence Hall's Older Adolescent Program provides young adults with comprehensive services designed to meet their individual needs as they prepare to emancipate from the child welfare system. Our two-level program serves youth between the ages of 17 and 21 to help them successfully complete high school and gain work experience while providing them with a support system for long-term stability.

## Lawrence Hall Raises Over \$200,000 at Sold Out 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala

CHICAGO, IL – Chicago's oldest social services agency Lawrence Hall recently celebrated its 150th Anniversary of serving communities and children with a sold out Gala held on Saturday, September 26, at The Harold Washington Library at 401 S. Plymouth Ct. As a result, \$200,000 was raised through the night's sponsorships and events to benefit Lawrence Hall's programs.

Since 1865, Lawrence Hall has been delivering quality care to children and their families throughout the metropolitan Chicago area, many of whom have experienced significant traumas in their lives. Lawrence Hall currently cares for nearly 1,000 children and families each year in Illinois, equipping them with the tools and skills they need to set them on the path toward becoming proud, productive participants in society.

The sold out event had over 400 guests, with Anthony Ponce of NBC 5 Chicago serving as the evening's emcee. Lifelong Lawrence Hall Trustee Charles W. Sample was given the Champion for Children Award for his tireless dedication and support to Lawrence Hall and its mission.


