 - Two letters of recommendation addressing musical, clinical, and professional skills of applicant. *One must be from Academic Director confirming eligibility.
 - A DVD/flash drive recording of the applicant performing three songs of popular genres:
 1. A capella voice
 2. Piano with voice accompaniment
 3. Guitar with voice accompaniment
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Upon review of the application and required documents, the Internship Director will contact the applicant regarding an interview/audition. An internship agreement from the academic institution will be required upon acceptance. A legal affiliation agreement is not required by Lawrence Hall.

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*Initial interview may be over the phone; however an onsite interview/audition is required for acceptance into the internship. During the onsite interview, the applicant may be required to sight read 1-2 chord charts on piano and/or guitar.

Administrative requirements prior to start date include (*costs assumed by Lawrence Hall*):

1. Physical
2. TB test
3. Drug screen
4. Background check
