TFFH Foster Parents reside in an agency-owned home and provide loving care and support for up to four youth between the ages of 10 to 15.

WHO CAN BE A TFFH FOSTER PARENT?

TFFH Foster Parents typically have two years of specialized foster parenting experience and maintain full-time residence in our single-family house in the beautiful Albany Park neighborhood. While both single and married foster parents are welcome, at least one parent must always be home as an integral member of the children's treatment team.

- After-hours crisis support
